Minutes

May 14, 2011 Meeting

The May 14 meeting of the Jackson County OGS Chapter was called to order by President Charles Weese at 10:35 a.m. in the Potter Room at Jackson City Library.

In attendance were Mr. Weese, Donna Scurlock, Sally Fritcher, Marilyn Ebaugh, Ruth Hayth, Betty Saltsman, Linda Walton, Phoebe Canter, Don Dearing and Mike Deaterla.

Minutes of the April 9 meeting submitted by Larry Patrick were approved following a motion by Linda Walton and second by Betty Saltsman.

Mr. Weese reported the treasurer's report submitted by Mr. Patrick indicated a General Fund balance of \$5,424.25 and a cemetery account balance of \$920.01, both effective April 29, with \$331.71 transferred to the cemetery account from first quarter CD sales.

No committee reports were given.

Under old business, Mr. Weese announced plans for working on digitizing a funeral home book for CD, and plans for a committee to meet soon to discuss future programs.

Under new business, Mr. Weese announced, the Liberty Township JP Criminal Docket has been scanned, and includes roughly 250 pages, but still needs to be indexed. He indicated plans to place the index on the chapter website. Digitalization training for those interested, newspaper advertising, and purchase of a GPS receiver for cemetery mapping were on the agenda but not discussed due to absent members.

Guests Sally Fritcher of Springfield, Ill., and Marilyn Ebaugh of Westminster, Md., shared their experiences researching local ancestors and resources.

The next meeting is planned Saturday, June 11, 2011, at 10:30 a.m. in the Potter Room.

With no further business, the meeting was dismissed at 11:15 a.m.
