



Jackson County Chapter of the Ohio Genealogical Society Meeting Minutes - September 10, 2011

The Sept. 10, 2011 meeting of the Jackson County Chapter OGS was called to order by President Charles Weese at 10:32 a.m. in the Potter Room at Jackson City Library.

In attendance were Charles Weese, Don Dearing, Phoebe Canter, Cynthia Walker, Kathleen Mackey, Donna Scurlock, Mary Tipton, Linda Walton, Mike Deaterla, Ruth Hayth, Larry Patrick and Bob Ervin.

Minutes of the August meeting were read and approved following a motion by Don Dearing, seconded by Donna Scurlock. The treasurer's report showed a general fund balance of \$4,983.31 and a cemetery fund balance of \$1,122.76 as of Aug. 31.

Under committee reports, Ruth Hayth made a motion, seconded by Donna Scurlock, for monies from 2012 calendar sales to be placed in the cemetery fund at the request of Anthony Coyan. The motion was approved.

Future publications, the First Families Project and store items donated to Lillian Jones Museum were listed under old business, with no new information available.

Under new business, Mr. Weese encouraged new membership ideas. Discussion regarding chapter presence for the September Apple Festival was conducted, with a library table considered unless the Historical Society or another location found and staffing available.

Ruth Hayth passed around a Historical Society projects letter.

Chapter calendars for 2012 should be at the printers' by Sept. 6 and available in time for the festival at a suggested price of \$6 each. Calendars cost \$3 each to print, with 100 copies ordered.

Mr. Weese called for volunteers for a nominating committee. Mr. Deaterla indicated chapter bylaws call for two-year terms, making elections unnecessary for 2011.

Programs for the remainder of the year were discussed, with several speakers mentioned.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:53 a.m. with a program by Mr. Ervin about his historical writing experiences following.
