Meeting Minutes – April 9, 2016



The April 9, 2016 meeting of the Jackson County Chapter OGS was called to order by President Donna Scurlock at 10:40 a.m. in the Jackson City Library. Treasurer's Report:

Committee Reports:

1. Bob Lewis has accepted appointment as Chairman of the Lineage Societies. Other committee members are Mike Deaterla, Beverly Griffiths and Larry Patrick.
2. Megan attended the recent Bicentennial Committee meeting. There was not a large response from reenactors. The committee proposed to diversify the offerings with a variety of activities including perhaps geocaching. The next meeting had not been set by the time of the April JCOGS meeting.

Old Business:

1. We still need to try to find something to give to OGS as part of the 8 for 88 program.
2. Megan was in a discussion with the Jackson City Auditor who said the museum can contract with someone legally for pay. We discussed the matter and decided that JCOGS and the LJM will draw up a contract to split the costs of contracting with someone to work in the Carriage House 9 to 15 hours per month at \$7.25 per hour beginning in May 2016 and running through May 2017 when the contract can be reevaluated. Mike motioned to start the action the second week of May 2016 contingent upon the museum board acting to approve the contract. Beverly seconded the motion. It passed.
