Received the Copy "History of Jackson Co., Oh." by Daniel Webster Williams 1900. with your Index. To have a Book Reprint with your Society's Index of its contents, the first year of your Society is quite an accomplishment. You must have a good & active group of persons in your Society. I salute all of you.

Many of my husband's ancestors are mentioned on p. 46. We read an interesting account of a Large Bear killed by the 3 Stephenson Brothers James Samuel & Smith Stephenson. Samuel b. Dec. 31, 1799 in Va. was my husband's gt. grandfather. James Jr. their father had come to Jackson Co. in 1818 from Monroe Co., Va. (W. Va.), and Margaret Smith in Bath Co., 1796 & settled in Franklin Twp. Samuel b. 1799 settled in Hamilton Twp. We have visited the sm. Cem. on the Homestead farm of James Jr. in Franklin Twp. on Seymour Creek. here James Jr. & Margaret are buried also son Smith. We had some lg. Sapling trees cut down around the stones in 1951. & copied all inscriptions.

John Stephenson, the 1st commissioner of Jackson Co. was m. Nancy Ewing was an uncle to Samuel Smith & James. He settled in Bloomfield Twp. Jackson Co. Oh.

Book mentioned also Samuel Mc Clure, a gt. gt. grandfather of my husband. He had m. Nancy Lindsey they b. in Bloomfield Twp. also, from Greenbush Co., W. Va. To Jackson in 1811. Guess it was Pike Co. then. I am sending a Pedigree Chart of my husband's Lines in Jackson Co., Oh. to make it easier to follow. I hope we find some new cousins.

I had hoped the Book would have more on our Centers & Comers. I would like to hear from anyone having Center & Comer Lines.
