I am interested in obtaining information about Job FOSTER as listed on the enclosed form.

My husband's great-great-grandfather was Thomas Foster, b 1816 somewhere in Ohio and died 1860 in Newton, IL. This is as far as I can go back on this Foster family. However, there were several uncles and brothers named Job Foster. And one of them was named "Job Craycraft Foster". You will note that the Job Foster named on the enclosed form married a Nancy CRAYCRAFT. So I think there is a connection somewhere, but I have not as yet been able to find it.

I would be interested in finding out more information about this Job Foster(m. Nancy Craycraft), and also about his descendents, particularly his sons' descendents.....my Foster connection would have to come through them.

If you can help me in any way, or if you know of someone who can help me, I would certainly appreciate the information. There is probably a one or two generation gap between Job Foster and my Thomas Foster which I am particularly anxious to find. A SASE is enclosed for your convenience.
