I am interested in the Rhoades and Lewis families of Berlin X-roads in Milton twship. The 1850 census shows James & Elizabeth Rhoades with children there. I believe James to have passed away shortly after that. Have the cemeteries been tabulated in that area? I have checked the probate and will records but no luck.

The cemeteries I am interested in are

- ① Woodson ^{none} ② Baptist off Ohio 124
- ③ Cemetery ^{see above} South off Salem Rd. T-176
- ④ Mt. Zion ^{none} off Ohio 32 ^{all} in Milton twship

⑤ Rice ^{none} ⑥ Campbell ^{none} and ⑦ Keenan ^{none}
in Lick twshp and ⑧ Licks
and ⑨ Learner ^{none} in Coal twshp.

Please check for
Lewis' and Rhoades (or
any spelling) in these cem-
eteries. I will be glad to
pay for time spent and copying.

I have an old flat map of
Milton twshp (looks like 1877)
and this really looks like
mining country. Any info
on that appreciated too. The
family may have been miners.
James Rhoads and Elizabeth
Lewis were married 1833 and
an Andrew Lewis married
Eliza Mattox the same day.

By 1864 the family had
come into Mercer Co Mo.
but I've never found
any sign of James after

the 1850 census so wonder
if he was dead by then.

There daughter Mary Ellen
born in 1850, was a Methodist
so wonder if they would
have been members of a
Methodist Church (possibly the
Salem Methodist out by the
Cemetery on Salem Rd).

Any help would be so
much appreciated.

In Woodson - there were no Lewises or Rhoads (please note that that doesn't necessarily mean they might not be buried there).
