Dear Mrs. Hixon:

I enjoyed speaking with you in early December regarding the genealogy research project we are working on and am delighted that you will be able to help us. With the holidays I'm somewhat delayed in getting the background information to you.

We would like to find the death or last whereabouts of Sarah Madarra Woodford Campbell in the hopes that we can find out where in Pennsylvania she was born. She was the mother of Mary Woodford McGuire. We have traced Thomas McGuire and Mary Woodford up to the present.

We last find Sarah in Lick Twp., Jackson Cty., with her second husband, McKnight Campbell. He owned property valued in the 1860 census at \$500.

Her first husband, William Woodford, and also the object of our search since he was Mary's father, was last found in Bedford County, Wayne Twp. in 1840. Sarah had her first child with McKnight Campbell in 1843 so necessarily William Woodford must have died soon after 1840. There are no early death records in Belmont County. A search of existing marriage records in Belmont County do not reveal a marriage between Sarah and McKnight. There are quite a few people with the surname McKnight in Belmont County. I am telling you this for background information.

Family lore says Sarah was of Pennsylvania Dutch descent and her surname, Madarra or Madarry, bears this out. We also have reason to believe she may have been a Quaker. Indeed, her youngest son's obituary in 1937 said that he was a lifelong member of the Friends (Quaker) Church. Mary Woodford McGuire, however, was reported to have been a lifelong Methodist in her obituary in 1920 and was buried from the Methodist Church in Wellston. All of the McGuire Family as well as David Campbell, Mary McGuire's half brother, were buried in Wellston in Ridgewood Cemetery. Sarah may be buried there too, but as you know, the early records were burned.

We would be interested in Rosline Woodford's death, insofar as we might find out where she was born. It appears that James Woodford moved on, selling his property valued at \$4,200 and leaving Hocking County in 1873. I have soundexed 1880 and 1900 for him and for his male children in all the neighboring states but have not found them as yet. We would be interested in his death to find out where he was born. I will continue to check the soundexes to find where he went.

We have checked the 1870 census for Jackson & Hocking counties and the 1880 census for Star Twp. in Hocking and Lick & Milton Twps. in Jackson for Sarah & McKnight but lost track of them with the 1860 census.


We would appreciate your looking for (1) the sale or disposition of McKnight's property after 1860, or, if he died, who inherited it (2) The death of Rosline Woodford Wishard between 1857 and 1860 (William Wishard was 3 yrs old in 1860). We checked the Jackson newspaper for the period but did not find anything (3) Church records for the death of Sarah after 1860 or McKnight, if that will lead us to her.

Believe this is more likely than 1860 census which
gives her age as 36. She would have her born in
1824. 1840 shows her betw 20 and 30.

Died: After 1860

Located: Last found with McKnight (Mack) Campbell in
1860 census, in Jackson Cty, Ohio.
In 1850 lived in Pine Twp, Armstrong Cty, PA.
with McKnight Campbell & 7 children (Samuel not
born yet)
In 1840 with William Woodford in Wayne Twp
Bedford Cty, OH. He was a farmer.
In 1837, daughter Mary born in Frankstown, PA

Married: William Woodford, probably prior to 1832
when she would have been 14 or 15.
William Woodford reported to be from
Virginia in one reference and Pennsylvania
in another. She was widowed and then wed
McKnight (Mack) Campbell after 1840

Children: Rosline Woodford B. PA 1832

Rosline may or may not be Sarah's daughter.
William Woodford may have been married before
or she may be related in some other way.

Rosline may be the mother of William Wishard
(age 3) found with Sarah in 1860 census in

found in 1860 Census in Hawkins Mill, Milton
Twp. Jackson Cty. Age 32, a collier, from Pa.

We are sure that James Woodford was Mary's
brother since family lore mentions him.

M. Amanda Hutchison in Jackson City, OH
on July 31, 1856. Amanda born 1838
She is probably the daughter of
Hutchison of Jackson Cty, a collier from PA.
Jas. & Amanda found in 1860 Census in Vinton
Twp, Vinton Cty, OH - James is a teamster.
They are found in 1870 in Starr Twp, Hocking
Cty with six children and brother David
Campbell. James is a farmer. He sold farm
valued at \$4,200 in 1873 and moved on.

Mary Woodford B. Frankston, PA 8/13/1839
 M. Thos McGuire in
 Ironton. OH 6/31/1856
 D. Wellston, OH 12/2/1920

(Thomas was a coalminer, born in Ireland. He fought and was wounded in the Civil War. Mary received a pension upon his death. Pension records show her birthplace as Frankston and her mother's maiden name as Madarra.)
